- Yr 6 Graduation RSVP – we need numbers by Wed 4th Dec to confirm our booking

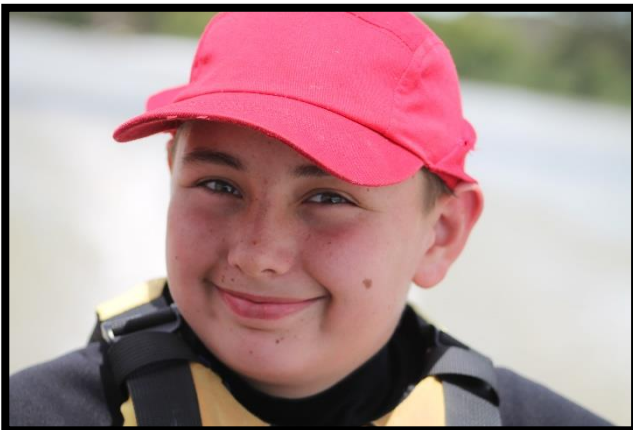
**It's nearly
